

Vaccination of CK Residents 80 Years and Older

The CK Vaccination Team will begin administering the Pfizer BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine to residents of Chatham-Kent 80 years of age and older beginning Saturday, February 27.

CK Public Health is advising citizens 80 years and older to please call the COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic booking centre starting **Saturday, February 27 at 8:30 am**

The vaccination clinic will take place at the John D. Bradley Centre at 565 Richmond Street, Chatham. It is by appointment only and drop-ins are not permitted. Scheduled appointments will begin Saturday February 27 at 9:00 am with the last appointment at 7:30pm.

Pre-registration is required. Appointments can only be booked by calling 519.351.1010.

Due to expected high call volumes initially, it may take multiple attempts to speak with a representative.

Please do not call your doctor's office or the Bradley Centre location.

The Vaccination Team is continuing to vaccinate the priority population in Phase 1 of [Chatham-Kent's vaccination plan](#).

Family and friends of adults 80 years of age and older are encouraged to support their loved one(s) in pre-registering for an appointment.
