



Barb Lather Bursary

The Thamesview Family Health Team awards a \$500 bursary each year to post- secondary school students who are studying in the healthcare field, have a local tie to Chatham-Kent and complete a training opportunity/placement with the team. This bursary was established in honour of Barb Lather who passed away in 2018.

Barb was an employee of Thamesview Family Health Team and she was passionate about helping to create a Centre of Excellence for future generations of health care professionals so that together, we can continue to improve the health of our community.

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a current student at a Canadian college or university
- Completed a training placement at Thamesview Family Health Team
- Have a local tie and/or connection to Chatham-Kent

A completed application form and a personal statement that touches on: (a) why you feel your training experience at Thamesview was a good fit for you; and (b) how winning this scholarship could further your future academic or career goals. You may add photographs or video to help support your submission.

Judging

A panel of judges appointed by the Board of Directors will judge each applicant's submission on the basis of the following weighted criteria:

Student Training Experience - 20 Points

Demonstrated Fit & Passion - 40 Points

Overall Quality of Submission - 40 Points

Total Score Maximum - 100 Points

Applicants will not receive their scores. Judging will be completed on or about May 15 and the scholarship winner will be announced on the Thamesview web site on or about June 1.

In the event of a tie between two or more entries based on total Score, the Entrant associated with the entry – from amongst all such Entries that are tied – with the highest score on Overall Quality of the Contestants' Submission will be deemed to be the eligible winner. In the event there continues to be a tie between two or more entries based on the score, all Entrant entries that are still tied will be entered into a random draw conducted by the Judges for Scholarship Prize.
